Wish List

Christine Cournoyer presented a 2026 wish list for changes to existing courts which included:

Ball Machine

The board discussed Troon's ball machine proposal for usage.

Booking courts for 1 hour instead of 1.5 hours during the summer

An SJPA member had suggested that courts be booked for 1 hour instead of 1.5 hours during the summer. The board recommended that court times stay as they are since players are free to take long breaks or to quit early. If feeling overheated, please take advantage of the airconditioned bathrooms to cool down.

CFIL

The CFIL is hoping to have 2 Lower Intermediate teams, 2 higher intermediate teams and 1 Advanced team.

Participation in the CFIL requires 50 DUPR games so coaches are holding sessions on Mondays and Wednesdays to give people the chance to get their scores in.

The coaches and rep will meet to determine who will play on each team.
